

3) STATE RESOURCES CENTRE FOR WOMEN

The primary objective of SRCW is to work for holistic empowerment of women in the State cutting across sectors. It will facilitate Government and other stakeholders involved in women empowerment issues to implement Gender sensitive programmes, laws and schemes through effective coordination. SRCW will regularly review and evaluate existing policies, programmes and legislations impacting women and bring suitable recommendations before the State Mission Authority (SMA) and National Resource Centre for Women (NRCW) for suitable measures. It will work for the convergence of women centric programmes / schemes of various central and state governments and Gender concerns integral to the planning process. SRCW shall create an environment through awareness generation to fuel demand by women for schemes / programmes and facilitate the process through which the gap between demand and supply can be reduced
